# 48th Annual March for Life

"For we are God's Masterpiece" Ephesians 2:10

This year, our **48**<sup>th</sup> **Annual March for Life**, will be a little different. Because of covid-19 and not being able to gather in large groups, the Diocese of Honolulu, along with the Hawaii Life Alliance and Knights of Columbus, has invited us instead to participate with a virtual prayer service, praise and worship with keynote speakers. The virtual event will emphasize the following important Life issues: *physician assisted suicide, euthanasia, sex-trafficking, adoption, foster care, suicide prevention and abstinence only education.* 



Bishop Larry Silva will also kick start the event with Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on **Thursday**, **January 21**<sup>st</sup> **at 6:00 p.m.**, **Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa**, **Honolulu.** Pre-registration is important for the Mass by logging onto: <a href="https://www.signupgenius.com/go/904054da5a62fa0f85-respect">https://www.signupgenius.com/go/904054da5a62fa0f85-respect</a>.

The event date and time is on **January 22**, **2021**, **Friday** between **4:00 p.m.** – **6:00 p.m.** "Virtual doors" open at 3:45 p.m. with Praise and Worship by the Tamala Ohana. The schedule also includes the displaying of pinwheels and banners with our theme, along with special messages from keynote speakers: Bishop Larry Silva, Arimathea Bennett from Students for Life, Pastor Waxer Tipton from One Love Ministries and more.

Here at our parish, we will hold a novena to pray for the Unborn and the vulnerable. The novena will be held from January 21 - 29, 2021 in the church. Time will be announced in next week's bulletin. We will also display the pinwheels in memory of the unborn. All are encouraged to come and participate in the novena.



# Pray for the repose soul of +Father Scott Bush

Many of you may know Fr. Scott Bush, who was pastor of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, Ewa Beach for a few years. Fr. Scott passed away on Saturday, January 2, 2021. Let us pray for the happy repose of the soul of Father Scott. He last served as Pastor of St. George Church, Waimanalo; Parochial Vicar at Sts. Peter & Paul Church, Honolulu; and Pastor of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church, Ewa Beach. He was born on April 7, 1950 and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Honolulu on June 6, 1992. May he rest in the peace of Christ!

#### **Parish Statistics**

Each year, the parishes in the Diocese are required to report the number of first communions, confirmations, marriages, deaths, etc. that is recorded in the canonical books. We also report the number of registered families in our parish, but we have never had an accurate count. The main reason for that is that when someone moves to another parish, they don't let the parish know they've moved. Because of this, our numbers are exaggerated.

We are trying to get a more accurate account of the number of registered families here at the parish. To do this, we have asked one of our volunteers to go through our database to see if we can identify our current members. If she doesn't recognize the members, she may call or email to update any information. If you are not comfortable giving any information, please call the parish office so that we can update the info here.
